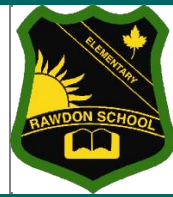

Actions / Initiatives to Develop

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, Rawdon Elementary was not able to survey gr 4-5 and 6 students through the OurSchool Survey.

Rawdon Elementary will concentrate on the same goal as the previous year reducing the percentage of students feeling bullied by 9 %. By reducing this percentage we are hoping to simultaneously decrease the percentage of students feeling anxious.

Rawdon Elementary wants to ensure that all stakeholder in the building feel a positive and safe school climate. Based on the Covid 19 situation we are aiming to conduct the OurSchool Survey by November. Our goal is to better understand the student's perspective and use the information provided by the survey results to fuel our 2020-21 ABAV Plan.

We are also participating in the OPTANIA pilot project which is a tool used to monitor as well as register bullying and violent events. This format will be replacing the ISM platform in 2021-2022.
