- To improve communication between the students in the school
- To increase student sense of belonging

Actions / Initiatives to Maintain or Let Go

1. Working in collaboration with pedagogical services (maintain)
2. SEL programs such as the Zones of Regulation / Dr. Melrose Hope and Healing (maintain)
3. Additional supervision (indoors) (maintain if needed ie. COVID regulations)
4. Non-Violence Squad offered by the Surete du Quebec (maintain)
5. Special Education Technician working with small groups to further develop social skills (maintain)
6. Providing more options/activities during recess and lunch (maintain)
7. Teacher training and use of restorative practices across all cycles (including preschool) to increase empathy and self-awareness (maintain)
8. Teacher training and implementation of talk to support classroom behavior in the preschool classrooms (let go)
9. Participation in the pilot project OPTANIA data management system (maintain)
10. Use of ACGC program to increase educational value among students (maintain)
11. Presenting the survey results to the students to open discussion (maintain)

Actions / Initiatives to Develop

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1. Investigate the situation on the buses to determine student well-being while being transported to school.
 2. Coordinate an action plan with all stakeholders regarding the buses (transportation, bus drivers, students and parents)
 3. Explore the development of an active student leadership group.
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
